



Bristol City Council (the Council) will shortly be opening the new play area on Horfield common, adjacent to the Ardagh bowling pavilion. To keep children and park users safe, it will be necessary to ensure that unauthorised vehicles do not use the pathway that runs along the park from Kellaway Avenue to the garage site. The Council will be placing removable lockable bollards at each end of the path. Authorised users will be provided with a key.

Residents and garage tenants should only use the entrance via Maple Road. If, having taken legal advice, you consider that you have a legal right to use this pathway for vehicular access please submit written evidence to the Council to enable it to consider the matter.
